As part of the conscientious efforts of NNPC Limited in executing the Refineries Quick Fix Project, the Honorable Minister of State for Petroleum Resources (HMSPR), Oil, Sen. Heineken Lokpobiri; the Group Chief Executive Officer (GCEO), NNPC Limited, Mele Kyari and other Senior Management Team have inspected the ongoing KRPC Quick Fix Project. The project inspection and facility tour was conducted by the Managing Director of Kaduna Refining and Petrochemical Company Limited, Dr. Mustafa Sugungun during the 14th Refineries Rehabilitation Steering Committee Meeting held in KRPC recently.

Speaking during the project inspection, Sen. Lokpobiri expressed optimism that with the significant level of progress by the contractor, Daewoo Engineering and Construction Nigeria Limited, the project will be completed by the end of 2024. He reiterated Federal Government commitment to end petroleum product importation

through the revamp of the nation's refineries. He said he would continue to hold key players involved in the rehabilitation project accountable as he guaranteed the support of President Bola Ahmed Tinubu in ensuring timely delivery of the project.

Also speaking, the GCEO, NNPC

Limited, Mele Kyari assured that the fuel plant will be restreamed by end of 2024 as the contractor have fully mobilized to site and commenced work earnestly.

He disclosed that after successful execution of 60,000 bpsd capacity of the fuels plant, the generated revenue will be utilized to restream other sections of the refineries such as the lubes and petrochemical plants.

He said plan has been made for the completion of the Build, Operate and Transfer model to ensure that pipelines are available for the transportation of crude oil to get the refineries on stream.

KRPC STAFF OF THE MONTH FOR MARCH 2024

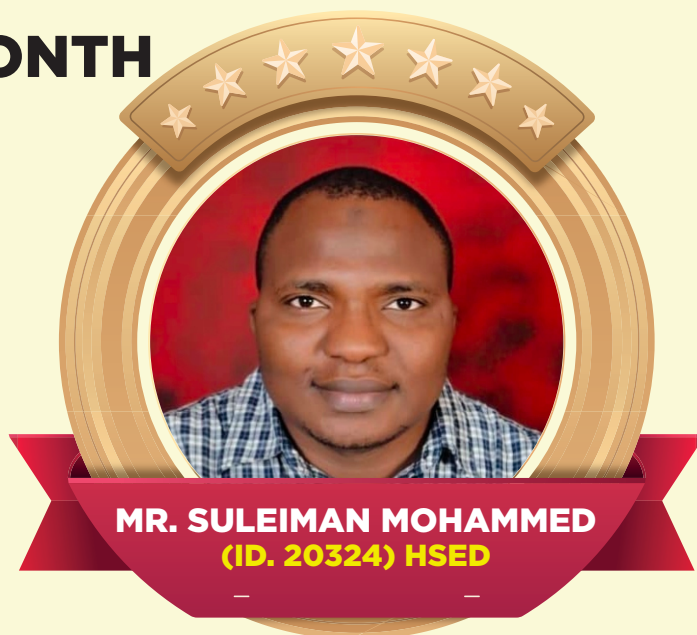

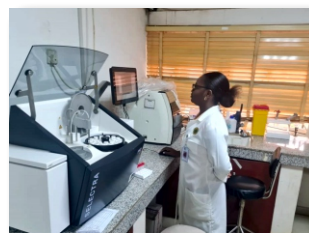
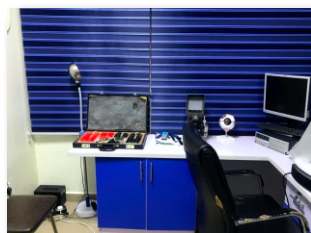
