Strategic Efforts

Ensure optimal facilities uptime, accelerate well intervention and reactivation programs, drive delivery of ongoing recovery initiatives with operators and continued collaboration with Operating Partners to sustain improved production performance.

Ajaokuta-Kaduna-Kano (AKK) Gas Pipeline:
AKK (Mainline): Continued collaboration with stakeholders to progress construction and installation activities geared towards achieving early gas to Abuja in 2026.

Obiafu-Obrikom-Oben (OB3) Gas Pipeline:
OB3 River Niger Crossing: Successfully completed the OB3 River crossing after relentless efforts from all critical stakeholders thus bringing Nigeria closer to realization of its strategic gas infrastructure development ambitions and assuring its energy security.

NNPC Foundation Public Impact Initiatives

Healthcare Intervention: On 29 April 2026, three rehabilitated and fully equipped wards with medical gas (G, H & J), with a total capacity of 102 beds, at the National Orthopaedic Hospital an 80-year-old national health institution, were successfully commissioned and handed over to the NOHIL Management. The rehabilitation of this facility significantly enhances orthopaedic care delivery in the Southwest region of the country and Nigeria at large.

Humanitarian Intervention: NNPC Limited, through the NNPC Foundation, has delivered humanitarian relief to communities in Mokwa, Niger State, following severe flooding in the area. The intervention included the distribution of food items and bedding materials to affected residents, reinforcing the Company's commitment to supporting vulnerable communities during emergencies.

NNPC Foundation Wins CSR Champion Award (Health): NNPC Foundation Limited/Gte. has been honoured with the CSR Champion Award (Health) 2025 at the Silver Jubilee edition of the Independent Newspapers Awards, held on 18 April 2026 at Eko Hotel and Suites, Lagos. The recognition celebrates the Foundation's outstanding healthcare interventions across Nigeria and its role as a catalyst for positive social impact, in line with the awards' theme, "Game Changers: Breaking Barriers and Shaping Tomorrow."

Youth Empowerment Programme: Delivered nationwide Basic Financial Literacy Training for NYSC 2026 Batch A Stream 2 across all 37 Orientation Camps on 26 April 2026 via online streaming, reaching 72,657 participants across the 36 states and the FCT and bringing the cumulative number of Corps Members trained under the programme to 1,303,738.
