



**Ajaokuta-Kaduna-Kano (AKK) Gas Pipeline:**

AKK Mainline: Successfully completed the mainline welding works as scheduled. Efforts are being intensified to complete the IPS and BVS.

**Obiafu-Obrikom-Oben (OB3) Gas Pipeline:**

OB3 River Niger Crossing: Successfully completed all early works and commenced Pilot Hole drilling. Project on course to be completed as scheduled.
